Subsidized tuition and fees for international students admitted into a non-Law program are \$13,700 (Singapore dollars) per year; \$15,080 (Singapore dollars) per year for Law program. Students who opt for this tuition grant will be bonded to work in any Singapore-registered company for three years upon graduation.
